**Important Installation Notes**

When the HMX 1050 User Station and HMIQDI are to be upgraded in conjunction with the HMX Mgr, it is recommended that the HMX Mgr is upgraded prior to upgrading the HMX 1050 User Station Receivers and HMIQDI Transmitters.

Ensure there are no mass storage devices attached to the HMX Mgr during its upgrade.

**How to Update Firmware**

1. Browse to the IP address of the HMX Mgr from a compatible computer.
2. Go to the HMX Mgr System tab and select the Upgrade utility.
3. You are prompted to browse to the location of the upgrade image.
3. Following the upgrade instructions provided by the upgrade wizard.

1. It is recommended to use the HMX Mgr as the administration tool for Receivers and Transmitters instead of using the local serial console administration utility at the Receiver.
2. When using the HMX Mgr to modify Receiver or Transmitter settings it is recommended that active sessions are disconnected from the specific Receiver or Transmitter before changing the settings.
3. Before backing up or restoring the database, it is recommended that there be no active sessions present. After restoring the database, it is recommended that you delete all units and add all units again.
